

Ken Goldman - Free Jewish Download- Sukkah egg bird decoration

This traditional egg bird sukkah decoration dates back to the 17th century the reason for the tradition is cloudy at best, but some feel that is to remind us of the verse that appears in piyutim read on Succoth -

"בצל כנפיך תסתירנו"

Whatever the source they sure make a great handmade decoration for your sukkah!

Raw egg
Small bowl
Sharp pin or needle
Scissors
String-(thin)
Glue (I like clear UHU)
"Free Jewish arts bird direction
page 1- printed on standard weight paper



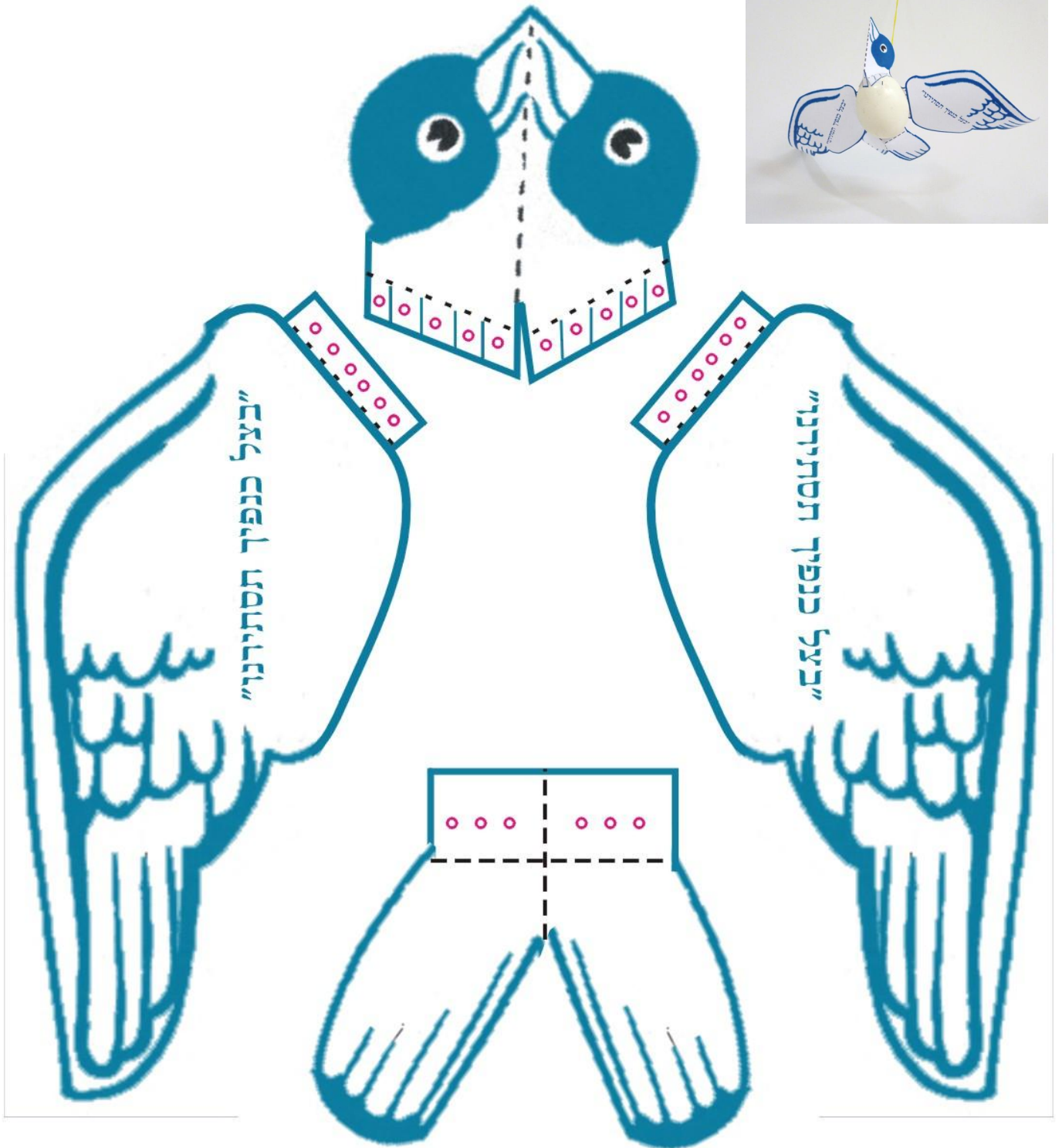
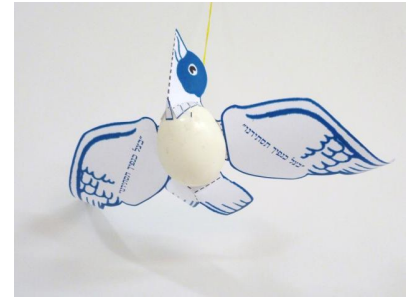
How to?

1. Wash egg
2. Holding egg over bowl-Carefully pierce top and bottom of egg with sharp pin -by rotating slowly- enlarge hole with pin till a tooth pick can fit in the hole
3. Insert toothpick in egg hole several times to pierce yolk sack.
4. Blow on one of the holes - egg should slide out into bowl (make an omelet)
5. Cut out bird sections from download- - cut on solid lines - fold on dotted lines
Place drops of glue on designated pink glue circles-
6. Place and hold sections in proper place for several minutes on empty egg
(refer to photo on page)
7. Knot end of string and glue to top of egg
