

Ken Goldman's "Upcycled olive oil can Chanukkiah" free Jewish arts download instructions



Moroccan Jews were upcycling way before it became fashionable. Tin cans of all types were recycled into unique chanukkiot. With this free Jewish arts download you can continue this wonderful tradition and recycle at the same time.

Israel Museum Hanukkah lamp Mazagan, Morocco



What you will need

- A. one responsible adult to help.
- B. print out of page 2 chanukkiah template2.
- C. empty olive oil can (2 litres or 5).
- D. tin snips.
- E. straight edge.
- F. Marker.

Instructions

1. Print and cut out chanukkiah template.
2. with adult supervision and work gloves use your tin snips to cut off top and bottom of can-and cut down side.
3. spread out can so it is flat - remember to wear gloves!!
4. wash off all traces of oil.
5. trace chanukkiah template to whatever area of the can you like most remember to mark fold lines as well.
6. carefully cut out shape.
7. bend along fold line- (you can use the edge of your table or a piece of wood to get a real straight fold).
8. bend up 8 candle tabs to 90 degrees.
9. Bend candle tabs around pencil forming a holder for each candle.
10. 8 candles should be folded inwards so that candle drips will fall on tin bottom- fold shammos tab outward so that it will also drip on tin bottom.
11. Finally sand all sharp edges with sandpaper.
